QUALITY OF WORK (must answer)

- Specifically identify (and attach) your very best work of the issue/deadline and describe in specific detail what makes it so.

AUTONOMY, MASTERY AND PURPOSE (optional)

- Describe a situation this issue/deadline where you demonstrated autonomy.
- Describe a situation this issue/deadline where you demonstrated mastery.
- Describe a situation this issue/deadline where you demonstrated purpose.

COLLABORATION (optional)

- Describe a time this issue/deadline where you worked with another staff member and something good happened because you did so. What is one thing you learned from the incident?
- Describe a time this issue/deadline where you worked with another staff member and it didn't go so well. What is one thing you learned from the incident?

GOALS (optional)

- Which goal are you most proud of achieving? Why? Which goal are you most disappointed in not achieving? Why?
- Set new goals for yourself for second issue/deadline.

DEADLINES (optional)

- Describe your deadline performance this issue/deadline.
- Craft a plan to meet all deadlines next issue/deadline and include three or more tips to help meet all deadlines.

CHALLENGE (optional)

- Describe a situation where you challenged yourself and failed.
- Describe a situation where you challenged yourself and were pleasantly surprised.

REFLECTION (optional)

- Describe a time this issue/deadline that you regret.
- Describe a time this issue/deadline that you wish more people witnessed.

LIFE LESSON (optional)

- Describe a situation in MV Media that taught you a life lesson. Be sure to articulate what happened, the lesson and what you learned.
- Describe one lesson, skill or trait you learned this issue/deadline and how it might improve your future.

FISH (optional)

- Describe times you saw each of the four principles actually work. Be sure to identify the principle in each of the four anecdotes.

EXPERIENCE “THE EXPERIENCE” (optional)

- Describe in story-telling detail a meaningful experience.
