Guidelines for submission

- Include event title in the poster version: Scholastic Journalism Week 2017 "Student Voice, Student Choice."
- Target market: Schools with journalism programs
- Color required: Full color but must also work in B&W
- Hi-Res Vector logo (Adobe Illustrator, InDesign, etc.)
- Submit your three visual identity creations in JPEG and PDF format (hi-res)
- Include datasheet (specifying fonts and Pantone colors)
- Include a short rationale with the thinking behind your visuals
- Include your name, school name, your publication, your grade level, email address and phone number. Also include your Twitter and Instagram handles if you have them so we can promote your entry!
