Broadcast journalism scholarship (up to \$2,000) sponsored by the Colorado Pro Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists

Deadline for applications: Jan. 31, 2017

This scholarship is open to high school seniors and college and university students attending any accredited U.S. college or university. To be considered, applicants must plan on entering a career in broadcast journalism and be from or living in Colorado.

Applications must include:

A concise cover letter that may include a statement of financial need. The letter should explain how the applicant intends to use the scholarship

An essay (no more than 500 words) that illustrates the applicant's writing abilities and plans for a career in broadcast journalism

Two recordings of audio or video stories broadcast by a school or professional media outlet The names and contact information for three references

A current resume

Applications must be postmarked or received at the email address below by Jan. 31, 2017.

Scholarship recipients will be notified in the spring and will be invited to attend an awards banquet in Denver. Half of the scholarship money will be paid to the student's institution. The other half will be awarded directly to the student. All award amounts will decided by the SPJ Scholarship Committee.
